Giant UFO almost collides with air force jet above crowd of people

Incredible footage of a UFO almost colliding into a jet during an air show has emerged online.

The video was shot in Puerto Varas, Chile last Friday while the Chilean high aerobatics squad pulled off a series of stunts above a crowd, mirror.co.uk wrote.

While one of the Halcones Fach's military planes zoned upwards, the hundreds of people gathered below noticed a disc appear out of nowhere.

And astonishingly it appears to narrowly graze the Air Force jet as it flashed across the sky.

Since the bizarre moment, witnesses

took to social media and online forums to report they had seen an unidentified object near the plane during the demonstration.

The footage has been posted on YouTube, and has racked up nearly 10,000 views — with many people speculating over what the object could be.

While some claim it is a spaceship, others suspect it might have been a meteorite or another plane, or even a passing bird.

“Yesterday, I saw a UFO in the sky — this was incredibly similar.”

Another commented: “I actually think there are two UFOs if you look carefully.”

Seventy-eight stone Eman Ahmed was flown from her home in Egypt to India on a specially modified cargo plane to undergo a series of operations to help her lose weight.

And since being put on a special 1,200 calorie a day diet the weight has been falling off.

Medics said that in her first five days at the hospital she lost a staggering 66lbs — more than 13lbs a day — after being put on a liquid diet. Doctors aim to reduce her weight by 200kg this year so she can fit on the operating table.

Bariatric Surgeon Dr. Muffazal Lakdawala said: “We need to get her in shape for the surgery.”

“The operation table can take the weight of 450kg but the width of the elevator is only 141cm. Eman is currently 151cm in width.”

Man practicing Parkour falls 40 feet down chimney

A 26-year-old man says he was making an action video with friends when he fell 40 feet (12.1m) down the chimney of a downtown Denver apartment building.

Dustin Hinkle told KCNC-TV that he and a couple of friends were making a Parkour video on the roof of the Denver City Lofts when he fell through a chimney cover.

Parkour involves moving

from point to point using obstacles along the way, abcnews.go.com wrote.

Hinkle plummeted down the old incineration chimney until a cable caught his fall.

He was stuck for nearly two hours until firefighters broke through a brick wall to get him out.

Hinkle, who along with his friends is facing a trespassing charge, said he thought he was

going to die and he didn't believe in God until he survived the fall.

The Denver Post reported that jail records show Hinkle is six feet and five inches tall and weighs 170 pounds (77.1kg).

Denver Fire Department spokeswoman Melissa Taylor told the Post: “It appeared to me to be a pretty small chimney.”

and said, “My sons, there is a great treasure hidden in one of my vineyards.”

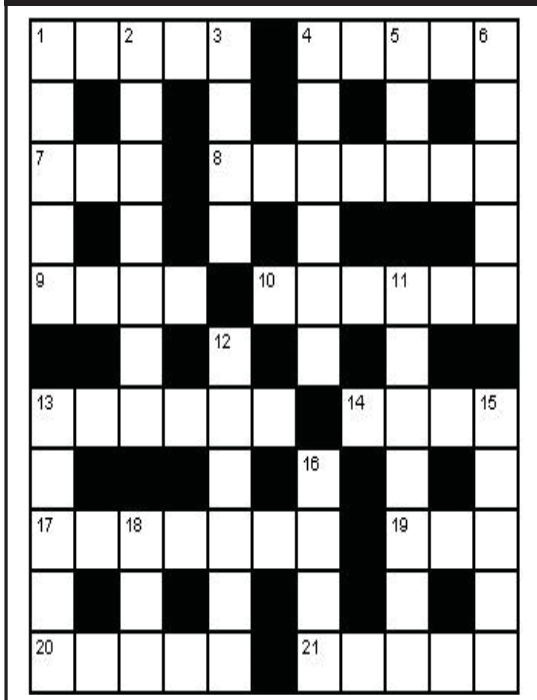
The sons, after his death, took their spades and mattocks and carefully dug over every portion

Quick Crossword



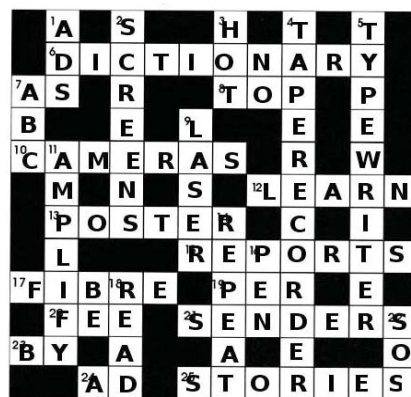
